Rua “Santa Catarina das Flores”: five hundred years in Porto’s urban structure

## Colloquium: **The street in the city structure**

**Venue:** Igreja/Museu da Santa Casa da Misericórdia, Porto (or via Internet)

**Date:** 11-13 November 2021

Planned or organically grown streets are part of the design of cities, and their faces are shaped and transformed by continuous occupation over time. Some streets and axes perform roles crucial to the understanding of urban growth identity. They have a genesis and a development. As living organisms occupied by residents and passers-by, their faces are slowly transformed. In a similar way, the functions that characterise them will develop over time.

As part of the celebrations to commemorate 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of Rua das Flores, in the city of Porto, we propose to hold this colloquium to reflect upon/study the role of the street in the urban structure and image.

- The street in urban iconography
- Functions of the street in city dynamics
- Formation, transformation and requalification of street buildings
